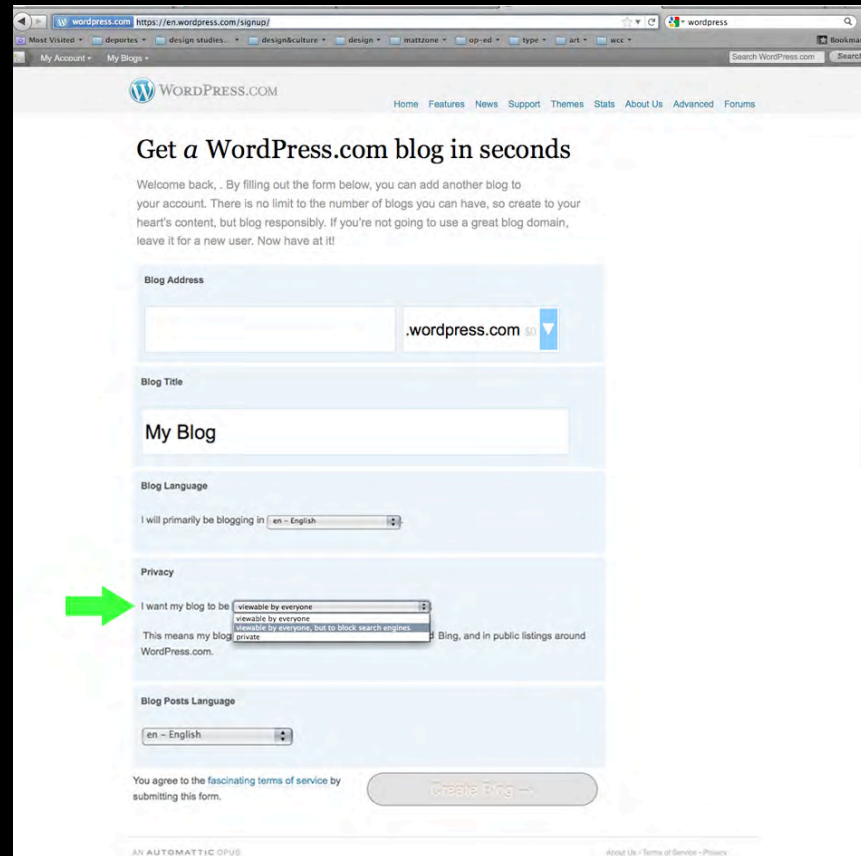
For use as your Course Portfolio Site, the title should be your first name followed by your last name. You can change the site title upon completion of this course.

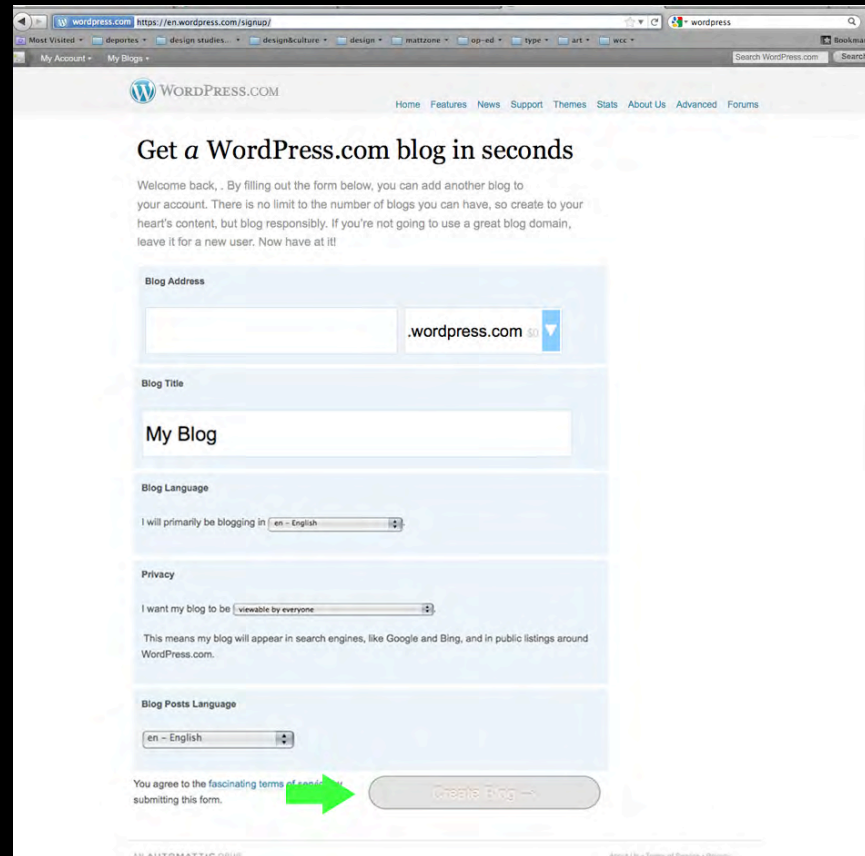

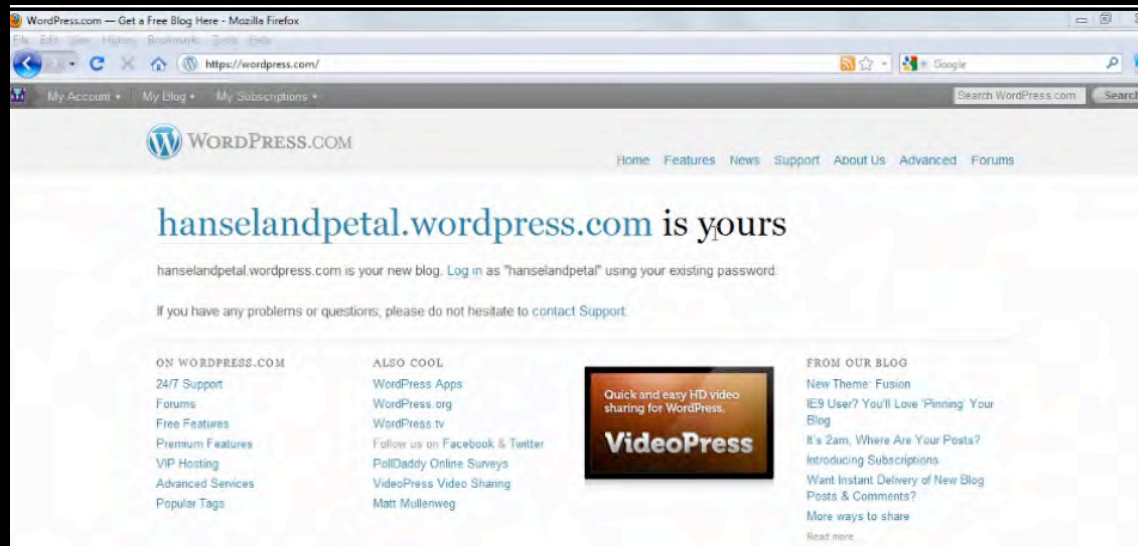

Confirmation page

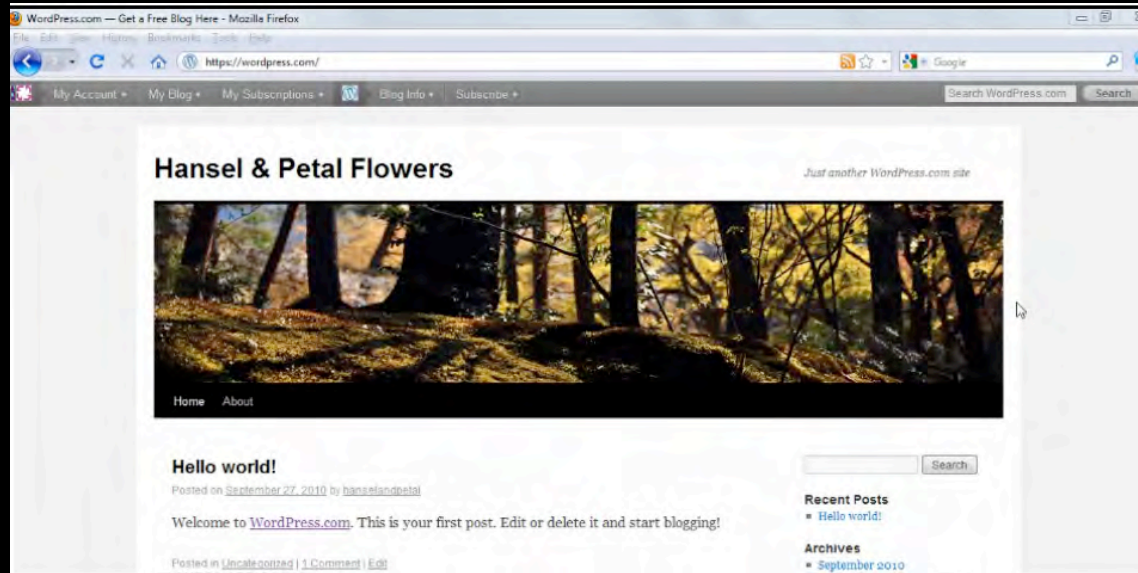
After filling in all the info and clicking the “create blog” button on the www.wordpress.com/signup page, your browser will open a page like this.

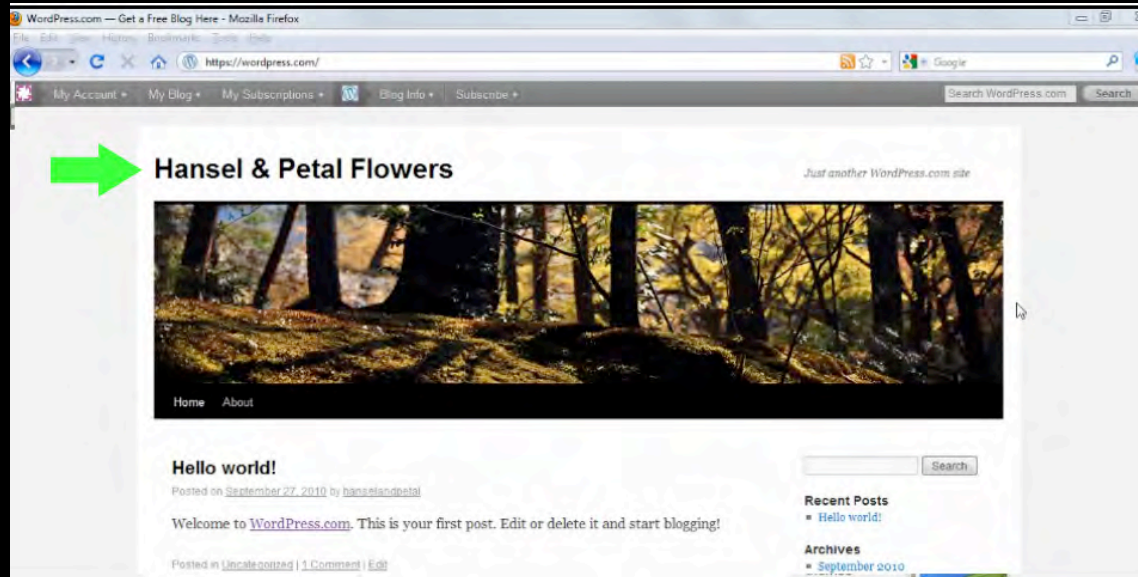
Click the blue type in the header and you will go to your new site.

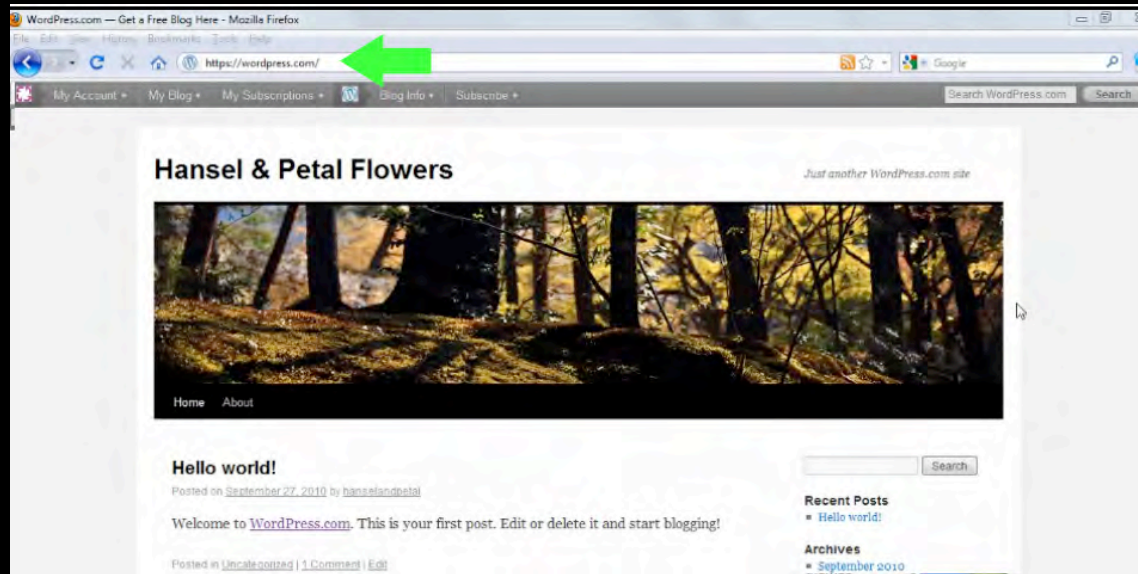
